Membership Updates – It's time once again to renew your membership in Yellow Thunder. Yellow Thunder Memberships expired on August 31st. Enclosed with this newsletter is an application blank, or you can complete the application blank on the back of this newsletter, and return it along with your dues. Please indicate on your application blank if you are interested in receiving the newsletter via e-mail, which saves Yellow Thunder significant postage. Thank you in advance for renewing your membership, and your continued support of Yellow Thunder.

Also, YT has a new fee structure for memberships. There is no longer a separate price for a single membership of \$20. A full, active club membership for family (including children under age 18, or 18+ but still in high school) or individuals is now a flat rate of \$25.00.

WI Snowmobile Trail Pass - The WI Snowmobile Trail Pass program continues, which means that all snowmobiles riding trails in Wisconsin are required to display a trail pass. This is separate from your registration decals. The annual WI Snowmobile Trail Pass will be available to snowmobilers from AWSC for \$10, provided you are a member of a snowmobile club and AWSC. Snowmobilers who are not members of **both** organizations will pay \$30 for the annual WI Snowmobile Trail Pass, and must obtain it from WDNR. For the latest, please go to www.awsc.org. Non-resident trail passes are \$50/year.

Please note a couple of important changes. Landowners – Yellow Thunder automatically makes you an honorary member of our club; however, we do not pay your AWSC dues. To qualify for the \$10 trail pass, you will need to join AWSC through a snowmobile club, which costs \$10. Please contact Yellow Thunder and we will coordinate your membership. Unmarried Partners – AWSC does not recognize unmarried couples for a family membership. Trail passes are linked to the registered owner of the snowmobile. Therefore, if you each own your own snowmobile, you will each need to join AWSC through a club, if you each want to qualify for the \$10 trail pass.

Miscellaneous - The attendance fund winner at the August meeting was Jessica Breunig. Since she was not present, the money carries over to the next meeting.
