WI Snowmobile Trail Pass – The WI Snowmobile Trail Pass program is permanent, which means that all snowmobiles riding trails in Wisconsin are required to display a trail pass. This is separate from your registration decals. The annual WI Snowmobile Trail Pass will be available to snowmobilers from AWSC for \$10, provided you are a member of a snowmobile club and AWSC. Snowmobilers who are not members of <u>both</u> organizations will pay \$30 for the annual WI Snowmobile Trail Pass, and must obtain it from WDNR. For the latest, please go to <u>www.awsc.org</u>. **<u>Reminders</u>**: Landowners – Yellow Thunder automatically makes you an honorary member of our club; however, we do not pay your AWSC dues. To qualify for the \$10 trail pass, you will need to join AWSC through a snowmobile club, which costs \$10. Please contact Yellow Thunder, and we will coordinate your membership. Unmarried Partners: AWSC does not recognize unmarried couples for a family membership. Trail passes are linked to the registered owner of the snowmobile. Therefore, if you each own your own snowmobile, you will each need to join AWSC through a club, if you each want to qualify for the \$10 trail pass.
