

Trails: Unfortunately, due to some snowmobilers who failed to stay on the marked trail last year and chose to cut across the field to get to trail #19 from Okee to County Road J, that trail is now closed. It is so important for riders to understand that 95% of our trail system is farmland. Going off trail can result in crop damage and affects our farmers' livelihood. If you need trail access, please contact the landowner. If you don't know who the landowner is, contact the club; we're here to help. Failure to contact the landowner increases the risk to lose more trails, and this impacts everyone who rides. Remember, riding is a privilege; not a right.

Yellow Thunder Scholarships: YT is once again offering two scholarships (\$250 each) for deserving club members pursuing secondary education. Applicants must meet several criteria; complete the application and profile forms; and submit a short essay on "What Snowmobiling Means to Me."
