AWSC Fall Workshop Recap – Just want to share a few items that were reported at the last meeting: ● 600 people attended. ● Rachyl Burzinski was crowned the 2022-2023 AWSC Miss Snowflake. She's from Beloit and will graduate from Gateway Technical College this Spring with a degree in Graphic Design. ● 2023 will be the 40th Anniversary MS Ride, which has raised over \$9.6M to date. ● AWSC offers 13 scholarships worth \$10,000 total, funded mostly by the KAOS silent auctions. <u>Trails</u>: Unfortunately, due to some snowmobilers who failed to stay on the marked trail during the 2020-21 season and chose to cut across the field to get to trail #19 from Okee to County Road J, <u>that trail remains CLOSED AGAIN for this season</u>. It is so important for riders to understand that 95% of our trail system is farmland. Going off trail can result in crop damage and affects our farmers' livelihood. If you need trail access, please contact the landowner. If you don't know who the landowner is, contact the club; we're here to help. Failure to contact the landowner increases the risk to lose more trails, and this impacts <u>everyone</u> who rides. Remember, riding is a privilege; not a right.

Yellow Thunder Scholarships: YT is once again offering two scholarships (\$250 each) for deserving club members pursuing secondary education. Applicants must meet several criteria; complete the application and profile forms; and submit a short essay on "What Snowmobiling Means to Me." Applications must be received by February 15, 2023, to be considered. The scholarships will be awarded in the spring.
