Safety Alert: If the trails ever open, please be careful if you are riding on Lake Wisconsin. It can be challenging for a number of reasons. There could be areas of thin ice due to the river's current. The lake also is known for ice heaves, which can create dangerous ice shifting that can stop a snowmobile in its tracks. Finally, there may be areas where the snow on the lake has been plowed by businesses or ice fisherman, leaving snow banks that can create a hazard for snowmobilers, so please be careful!
